How pro-life are you?

Much of the news lately is focused on the abortion bills being presented and passed by various states. New York, Virginia, and New Mexico have all presented bills that would allow or protect the right to abort babies up to and even immediately after birth. These are extreme permissions for abortion without any serious restrictions. What we are not hearing about is that the primary reason for bills like these are to preserve and expand the access to abortion. There is a good deal of fear in the abortion culture that Roe v. Wade will be overturned, so these states want to guarantee their legal right to abort.

We must remember that abortion is not a decision women make flippantly. Women don't find abortion enjoyable, they simply cannot imagine how they could carry-out their pregnancy in their current lifestyle and circumstance. They may not have any support from family members. Their employment might not be conducive to pregnancy, such as a labor job. Boyfriends or parents might demand she abort. Housing, child care, or clothing for the child seem unattainable. Some are from a strict religious family and she cannot imagine putting her family through the difficulty of an unplanned pregnancy. Most have no knowledge that the baby is a human being with a beating heart and his/her own blood type, rather they believe the lie that the child is simply a blob of tissue. There are those who already have three mouths to feed and her husband just lost his job. There are many reasons women choose to abort their children. The bottom-line is, they feel solely responsible for the pregnancy and it seems too great a task to handle alone.

So, I ask you, how pro-life are you? Are you pro-life enough to consider giving up something to help these women choose life? Would you give up 5 hours of your time to care for her while sharing the evidence based information about her three legal options, parenting, adoption and abortion?


